All candidates are required to deposit non-refundable application fee of ₹ 2,200/- (₹ 1,100 for SC, ST, ST-STA category of Rajasthan state) (through internet banking / credit card / debit card) by using the following details:

The application fee is not refundable, not transferable, and not adjustable for any future RCA Pharmacy. Any request in this matter shall not be entertained in future.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION:

All residents of India fulfilling the eligibility criteria mentioned below can apply for RUHS Pharmacy Lateral Entry Admission 2025, for admission through lateral entry to third semester of B.Pharm course in various private, self-financed pharmacy colleges, affiliated to Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur, based on instructions given in this information booklet, the relevant rules of PCI/RUHS, Jaipur, and directions of State Government.

- Educational Qualification:** A pass in Diploma in Pharmacy course
- Domicile criteria:** Lateral entry Admission is open to all residents of India. However, preference shall be given to alumni of RUHS, prior to the other University candidates of Rajasthan domicile, and candidates from other states.

FEE STRUCTURE:

The fee structure for the B.Pharm course for the academic year 2024–2025 is as follows:

- ₹75,600 per annum for RUHS College of Pharmaceutical Sciences (Government College)
- ₹1,08,000 per annum for Private Colleges

In addition, a caution deposit of ₹7,500 is applicable, which is refundable.

Any change in fee structure by the State Level Fee Fixation Committee will be applicable to all the candidates. The candidates are required to pay the prescribed fee to the allotted institutions directly on reporting.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Before filling the application form, read the information booklet etc. very carefully. Ensure the eligibility and other requirements for admission as given in this booklet.

You should be very careful in filling-up the online application form. Incomplete applications will not be entertained for allotment and applications with wrong information will lead to disqualifying the candidature at any time of the course of admission and education.

Fill the application form, option form, and complete it and uploading the following documents (scanned PDF files separately):

1. Transaction document / payment proof
2. Date of Birth Certificate: 10th class mark sheet / certificate
3. Mark sheet of 10+2 (senior school certificate examination) or its equivalent
4. Copy of photo ID (Driving License / PAN card / Voter ID / Govt. or PSU card / School ID card / 12th class examination Admit Card / Aadhar Card) (Essential)
5. Mark sheet of D.Pharm Part I and Part II examination (Essential)
6. Degree / provisional certificate of D.Pharm (Desirable)
7. Domicile certificate of Rajasthan state, if applicable
8. Caste certificate, if applicable
9. Any other relevant certificate(s)

Prepare two sets of photocopies of the above testimonials and the Original Certificates and keep one set safely with you for submitting at the time of joining at the allotted college.

The RUHS / Admission Board reserves its right to alter and modify time and conditions laid down in the notification, information booklet for conducting the various stages up to the admission, duly intimating details thereof on the RUHS website, as warranted by any unforeseen circumstances arising during this process, or as deemed necessary by the RUHS / Admission Board at any stage.

ADMISISON PROCEDURE:

The admissions shall be made strictly in accordance with merit list prepared based on D.Pharm percentage and the order of choices / options filled in by the candidates in the option form. Preference shall be given to alumni of RUHS, prior to the other University candidates of Rajasthan domicile, and the candidates from other states. The candidates are advised to exercise their choices/ options very carefully.

IMPORTANT TO NOTE: If at any stage, it is found that a non-eligible candidate is admitted to a course, then the admission of such a candidate will be cancelled on such detection. A penal action may also be initiated against such candidate.

The allotment of college and course shall be made by strictly following the order of merit, seats available in each college and the priority of choice/option of the college filled in by the candidate in the application form.

The allotment process shall include the colleges approved by PCI, New Delhi and RUHS.

Candidates securing equal marks in D.Pharm will be admitted in the following order of preference:

1. One who has obtained higher aggregate marks in 10+2 examination
2. The candidate of higher age (older candidate).

After allotment of college, candidates will be informed about their allotment at RUHS website. Candidate is required to take a printout of the page showing his/her allotment and join at the allotted college with this printout along with requisite documents, in original, and prescribed fee, by the notified date.

The non-viewing of the RUHS website about allotment information by the candidate shall not be accepted as a ground for non-joining at the allotted college on the scheduled time and date. The candidate's allotment will stand automatically cancelled if he/ she does not report IN PERSON to the allotted college as per notified schedule.

No further allotments will be done by RUHS Pharmacy Lateral Entry Admission 2025, after the scheduled FINAL round. The classes will be started immediately after Final round of allotment and further admissions will not be entertained by the RUHS Pharmacy Lateral Entry Admission 2025.

JOINING AT ALLOTTED COLLEGE AND DEPOSITING OF FEES & OTHER DOCUMENTS:

At the time of joining at the allotted college, the candidate will have to carry printout of the allotment letter. The candidate is required to deposit prescribed fee along with original and one set of attested photocopies of requisite documents.

The allotment list shall be provided to the colleges. The colleges shall verify the credentials of reporting candidates as per this list and check the documents and other required certificates with originals.

Admissions on the vacant seats, drop-out seats

No admission shall be made after a date as notified by RUHS / Admission Board (15-01-2026).

The decision of the RUHS / Admission Board shall be final and binding to all.

You should make sure of your eligibility etc. and that the declaration made by you in the format of application regarding your eligibility is correct in all respects. You will be liable to any legal action and / or punishment as may be deemed fit by the RUHS Pharmacy Lateral Entry Admission 2025, in case it is found that you have furnished in-correct information or made false declaration regarding your eligibility at any stage or suppressed any information.

The jurisdiction for legal cases arising out of RUHS Pharmacy Lateral Entry Admission 2025 shall be limited to the High Court of Rajasthan, Jodhpur/ Jaipur Bench.

The apex court drew guidelines for the management of all educational institutions, among them:

Educational institutions should take anti-ragging measures right from the time of advertisement for admissions.

The information brochure, the form for admission and/or any other literature issued to aspirants for admission must clearly mention that ragging is banned in the institution and anyone indulging in it is likely to be punished appropriately which may include expulsion from the institution, suspension from the institution or classes for a limited period or fine with a public apology.

The punishment may also take the shape of:

- ❖ Withholding scholarships or other benefits
- ❖ Debarring from representation in events
- ❖ Withholding results
- ❖ Suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess.

All legislations governing ragging or any provisions in statute/ordinance, it should be brought to the notice of the students/parents seeking admissions. A printed leaflet detailing when and to whom a victim may turn for information, help and guidance for various purposes, keeping in view the needs of new entrants, along with their addresses and telephone numbers should be given to fresher at the time of admissions that they need not to look to seniors for help in such matters.
