## 12. RESERVATION

**12.1** The reservation of seats will be made subject to statutory provisions of Govt. of Rajasthan for Rajasthan domicile candidates. Candidates belonging to reservation categories of states other than Rajasthan shall be allotted seats in the unreserved category.

**12.2** Candidates will be required to submit the Caste Certificate, Caste Validity and Non Creamy Layer Certificate, if applicable, at the time of filling Online Application Form and at the time of joining allotted college to be considered under the category.

**12.3 PwD:** 5% seats within each category (horizontally) shall be reserved for candidates with specified disabilities (PwD) under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and in accordance with *Appendix H-1* of Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997 of MCI as amended on 14.05.2019.

On the notified date, the PwD candidate must produce PwD certificate (issued by Competent Authority) during physical disability verification before the Medical Board constituted by RUHS, Jaipur for the purpose.

- 12.4** Candidates seeking benefit of reservation shall be required to produce for verification, at the time of joining at the allotted college, the original and valid certificate (SC, ST, ST-STA, OBC Non creamy layer, MBC Non creamy layer, EWS) or the additional category original and valid certificate (PwD, *if applicable*) issued by the competent authority and submit attested copies of the above documents.
- 12.5** OBC/MBC candidate must submit original OBC/MBC Certificate for Rajasthan State issued by competent authority of Rajasthan (issued within last one year of the date of conduct of the RUHS M.Sc. Nursing Entrance Exam-2025, RUHS M.Sc. (Med.) Entrance Exam-2025, and RUHS M.P.H. Entrance Exam-2025 and clearly indicating 'Non Creamy Layer') at the time of joining.
- 12.6** EWS candidate must submit original EWS Certificate for Rajasthan State issued by competent authority of Rajasthan (valid for financial year 2025-26) at the time of joining.
- 12.7** All reservation will be applicable only for Round 1 and Round 2 counselling process. During Round 3 and Open Round counselling, there will be no reservation applicable. All candidates will be treated as unreserved.
- 12.8** All reservations policies are applicable as notified by Government of Rajasthan from time to time.

### **13. DOMICILE CRITERIA**

- Admission to the course is open to all residents of India.

### **14. MEDICAL FITNESS**

- A candidate desirous of admission will have to deposit the medical fitness certificate at the time of joining to the allotted college on the prescribed form certified by a medical officer of the Government of Rajasthan as per the medical standards.

### **18.2 Master of Public Health (M.P.H.)**

**18.2.1** There shall be 100 objective type questions. Each question shall have four options to answer, out of which only one shall be correct. (+1) mark shall be awarded for each correct answer, (0) mark for an incorrect answer or un-attempted questions. There shall be no negative marking.

### **18.3 Master of Science (M.Sc.Med.)**

**18.3.1** There shall be 100 objective type questions. Each question shall have four options to answer, out of which only one shall be correct. (+1) mark shall be awarded for each correct answer, (0) mark for an incorrect answer or un-attempted questions. There shall be no negative marking.

### **18.4 Master of Science (M.Sc. Radiation Technology)**

**18.4.1** There will be no entrance examination for Master of Science (M.Sc.RT). Admission to be done through merit prepared on the basis of marks obtained at graduation level.

### **18.5 PG Diploma in Perfusion Technology**

**18.5.1** There will be no entrance examination for P.G. Diploma in Perfusion Technology. Admission to be done through merit prepared on the basis of marks obtained at graduation level.

## **19 COMMON INFORMATION FOR PG ADMISSION ENTRANCE EXAM**

**19.1** The entrance examination (Off line mode MCQ Based) of 120 minutes duration in English language will be conducted (at the examination center) at Jaipur city only.

RUHS reserves the right to create new centre for RUHS M.Sc. Nursing Entrance Exam-2025, RUHS M.Sc. (Med.) Entrance Exam-2025, and RUHS M.P.H. Entrance Exam-2025 in the cities other than Jaipur within the state. Candidates trying to use unfair means shall be disqualified from the admission. No correspondence whatsoever will be entertained from the candidates.

- 19.2 The common merit list shall be made strictly on the basis of score obtained in RUHS M.Sc. Nursing Entrance Exam-2025, RUHS M.Sc. (Med.) Entrance Exam-2025, and RUHS M.P.H. Entrance Exam-2025 admission shall be made on the basis of score obtained and the order of choices / options filled online by the candidates.
- 19.3 The syllabus for RUHS M.Sc. Nursing Entrance Exam-2025, RUHS M.Sc. (Med.) Entrance Exam-2025, and RUHS M.P.H. Entrance Exam-2025 is available at the RUHS website separately.
- 19.4 The candidates will be allowed to take along question paper/ OMR Carbon copy after completion of test.
- 19.5 Admit card will be available for downloading at the RUHS website and not be sent by individual post.
- 19.6 All candidates are required to appear in the RUHS M.Sc. Nursing Entrance Exam-2025, RUHS M.Sc. (Med.) Entrance Exam-2025, and RUHS M.P.H. Entrance Exam-2025 at their own expenses. No TA/DA will be paid to candidates for appearing in RUHS M.Sc. Nursing Entrance Exam-2025, RUHS M.Sc. (Med.) Entrance Exam-2025, and RUHS M.P.H. Entrance Exam-2025. The appearance in the RUHS M.Sc. Nursing Entrance Exam-2025, RUHS M.Sc. (Med.) Entrance Exam-2025, and RUHS M.P.H. Entrance Exam-2025 will not confer any right upon the candidate to be admitted in the prescribed courses of RUHS, Jaipur and MMU, Jodhpur.
- 19.7 Candidates trying to use unfair means shall be disqualified from the admission. Further necessary action (if applicable) will be taken by RUHS. No correspondence whatsoever will be entertained from the candidates.

## **20. COUNSELING FEE**

- 20.1 After appearing in the RUHS M.Sc. Nursing Entrance Exam-2025, RUHS M.Sc. (Med.) Entrance Exam-2025, and RUHS M.P.H. Entrance Exam-2025 to participate in the counselling process, eligible candidates will be required to fill choices of the course and college (in order of preference) by paying counselling fee as mentioned below:

- 21.1 After declaration of RUHS M.Sc. Nursing Entrance Exam-2025, RUHS M.Sc. (Med.) Entrance Exam-2025, and RUHS M.P.H. Entrance Exam-2025 result the eligible candidates will be allowed to participate in the online counselling process.
- 21.2 The eligible candidates will be required to fill choices of the course and college (in order of preference).
- 21.3 Guidelines for filling the choices and making online payment of counselling fee will be available at the RUHS website in due course.

## 22. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 22.1 The admissions shall be made strictly in accordance with merit list prepared on the basis of score of the RUHS M.Sc. Nursing Entrance Exam-2025, RUHS M.Sc. (Med.) Entrance Exam-2025, and RUHS M.P.H. Entrance Exam-2025 and the order of choices / options filled-in by the candidates on-line. The candidates are advised to exercise their choices / options very carefully.
- 22.2 For M.Sc. (RT) and M.Sc. (PT) Admission to be done through merit prepared on the basis of marks obtained at graduation level.
- 22.3 Candidates are advised to visit regularly RUHS website ([www.ruhsraj.org](http://www.ruhsraj.org)) for updated information about admission process.

**Important note:** If at any stage, it is found that a non-eligible candidate is admitted to a course, then the admission of such a candidate will be cancelled on such detection. A penal action may also be initiated against such candidate.

## 23. ALLOTMENT OF COLLEGE AND COURSE

- 23.1 The allotment of college and course shall be made by strictly following the order of merit, seats available in each college and the priority of choice/option of the college and the course filled-in by the candidate on-line.
- 23.2 Provided that, in case of equal score in RUHS M.Sc. Nursing Entrance Exam-2025, RUHS M.Sc. (Med.) Entrance Exam-2025, and RUHS M.P.H. Entrance Exam-2025, the relative merit of Candidates shall be resolved in the following order of preference and methodology as specified below-
- (1) The candidates with less number of attempt in passing UG Examination

- (2) Higher percentage in UG Course (aggregate of all years/semesters).
  - (3) The candidate of higher age (older candidate).
- 23.3 After allotment of college and course, allotment list will be declared on RUHS website. Candidate is required to take a printout of the allotment letter / information and join at the allotted college with this printout along with requisite documents, in original, and prescribed fee, by the notified date.
- 23.4 The non-viewing of the RUHS website about allotment information by the candidate shall not be accepted as a ground for not submitting the option form or non-joining at the allotted college on the scheduled time and date. The candidate's allotment will stand automatically cancelled, if he/she does not report IN PERSON to the allotted college as per notified schedule.

## **24. JOINING AT ALLOTTED COLLEGE AND DEPOSITING OF FEES AND OTHER DOCUMENTS**

- 24.1 At the time of joining at the allotted college, the candidate will have to carry printout of the allotment letter. The candidate is required to deposit the prescribed fee along with original documents and one set of attested photocopies of requisite documents. The colleges shall be provided the list of candidates allotted. The colleges shall verify the credentials of reporting candidates as per the allotment list and check the documents and other required certificates with originals.
- 24.2 In case of non-reporting/non-joining by the candidates at the allotted college in round 1, candidate shall not be eligible to participate in subsequent round(s) of online counselling.
- 24.3 Conditions relating to bond (Wherever Applicable for Government Colleges/ Government Self-Financed college). For M.Sc. Nursing in consonance with Govt. of Rajasthan letter no. P7(3) Nursing/DME/2014, dated 13/10/2020, the candidates allotted a seat in Government colleges/Government self-financed Nursing Colleges will have to submit a bond in prescribed proforma amounting to Rs. 50,000 (Rupees fifty thousand). If the candidate leaves the course after second round of counselling (before completion of the course) due to any circumstances then such a candidate will have to pay Rs. 50,000 as penalty. **Refer Appendix-B for Proforma of the Bond.**

**Note:** *In-service candidates must obtain relieving letter from their appointing authority before joining at the allotted college. In case of non-submitting the relieving order from the appointing authority by the last date of joining, the admission will automatically be cancelled.*

## 25. ADMISSIONS ON THE VACANT SEATS, DROP-OUT SEATS

- 25.1 After 2 rounds of on-line counselling, if seats remain vacant either due to exhaustion of the merit list or due to non-joining of candidates at the allotted college, RUHS reserves the right to take appropriate decision to fill the seats remaining vacant.
- 25.2 **It is clarified that colleges shall not fill any seat directly at their own level.**
- 25.3 **No admission shall be made after the date as may be notified by RUHS.**
- 25.4 The admissions shall be treated as provisional subject to the final decision of any pending case(s) in any court of law, if applicable to these admissions. Further, the provisional status of admission shall be confirmed only after enrolment by the RUHS after document verification at the level of RUHS (documents as submitted by the candidate). Any circumstances-based decision relating to the admission/ counselling process may be taken by the Chairman E & R Cell, RUHS or Chairman Admission/ Counselling Board, RUHS which shall be final and binding on all concerned.
- 25.5 All the judgments relevant to these admissions, passed by any Hon'ble court of justice as well as rules existing at the time of making admissions will be applicable on these admissions and the candidates will have to abide compulsorily with such judgments, rules and the changes.
- 25.6 **The decision of the RUHS shall be final and binding to all.**

## 26. CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION AND REFUND OF FEES, RETURN OF DOCUMENTS BY INSTITUTIONS

- 26.1 The Candidate shall apply for cancellation of admission by submitting duly signed application to the allotted Institution before the start of last round of counselling process. The Institute shall consider the request made by candidate for cancellation as final. Upon such cancellation, the candidate shall lose the claim on the seat and such seat shall become available for further allotment. The Institute shall refund the fees to the candidate after deduction of **Rupees one thousand only towards processing charges and return all his/her original documents submitted to the Institute within two days from submission of duly signed application.**
- 26.2 Candidate shall not be entitled to any refund of his/her fee except the Security Deposit / Caution Money Deposit if the cancellation is effected by the candidate after the cut-off date by RUHS.
- 26.3 No institution, who has in its possession or custody, any document in the form of Certificates, Degree, Diploma or any other award or other document deposited with it by a person for the purpose of seeking admission in such institution, shall

refuse to return such Certificate, Degree, Diploma, award or any other document with a view to induce or compel such person to pay any fee or fees in respect of any course or program of study which such person does not intend to pursue or avail any facility in such institution.

The apex court drew guidelines for the management of all educational institutions to follow. Among them:

Educational institutions should take anti-ragging measures right from the time of advertisement for admissions. The prospectus, the form for admission and/or any other literature issued to aspirants for admission must clearly mention that ragging is banned in the institution and anyone indulging in it is likely to be punished appropriately which may include expulsion from the institution, suspension from the institution or classes for a limited period or fine with a public apology.

The punishment may also take the shape of:

- (i) withholding scholarships or other benefits
- (ii) debarring from representation in events
- (iii) withholding results
- (iv) suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess.

If there be any legislation governing ragging or any provisions in statute/ordinance, it should be brought to the notice of the students/parents seeking admissions. A printed leaflet detailing when and to whom a victim may turn for information, help and guidance for various purposes, keeping in view the needs of new entrants, along with their addresses and telephone numbers should be given to fresher at the time of admissions so that they need not to look to seniors for help in such matters.

- Note : 1. The “Certificate of Disability” shall be issued in accordance with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017 notified in the Gazette of India by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment [Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (*Divyangjan*)] on 15th June 2017.
2. The extent of “specified disability” in a person shall be assessed in accordance with the “Guidelines for the purpose of assessing the extent of specified disability in a person included under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016)” notified in the Gazette of India by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment [Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (*Divyangjan*)] on 4th January 2018.
3. The minimum degree of disability should be 40% (Benchmark Disability) in order to be eligible for availing reservation for persons with specified disability.
4. **The term ‘Persons with Disabilities’ (PwD) is to be used instead of the term ‘Physically Handicapped’ (PH).**
