RUHS M.Pharm Admissions 2025-26 in the constituent college and the colleges affiliated to RUHS Jaipur, MMU Jodhpur, for the session 2025-26 shall be made by RUHS in the following courses:

1. M.Pharm (Pharmaceutics) (2 years duration / 4 semesters)
2. M.Pharm (Pharmaceutical Chemistry) (2 years duration / 4 semesters)
3. M.Pharm (Pharmacology) (2 years duration / 4 semesters)
4. M.Pharm (Pharmaceutical Quality Assurance) (2 years duration / 4 semesters)
5. M.Pharm (Pharmacognosy) (2 years duration / 4 semesters)

APPLICATION FEE:

All candidates are required to deposit non-refundable application fee of ₹ 5,000/- (₹ 2,500 for SC, ST, ST-STA category of Rajasthan state) by selecting the available payment options on-line at the RUHS website).

The application fee is not refundable, not transferable, and not adjustable for any future Pharmacy Admissions. Any request in this matter shall not be entertained in future.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION:

All residents of India fulfilling the eligibility criteria mentioned below can apply for **Centralized admissions to M.Pharm course**, in constituent pharmacy college and colleges affiliated to Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur, or to Marwar Medical University (MMU), Jodhpur, for the session 2025-26, on the basis of instructions given in this information booklet, the relevant rules of PCI / RUHS, Jaipur and directions of State Government / Honorable Court.

Educational Qualification

At least 55% marks (aggregate of 4 years / 3 years for lateral entry admission) in Bachelor of Pharmacy of an Indian University or from an Institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India [50% in case of candidates belonging to SC / ST / OBC non creamy layer / MBC non creamy layer of Rajasthan state].

For candidates having CGPA, after converting CGPA to equivalent percentage, at least 55% marks (aggregate of 4 years/ 3 years for lateral entry admission) in Bachelor in Pharmacy of an Indian University or from an Institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India [50% in case of candidates belonging to SC / ST / OBC non creamy layer / MBC non creamy layer of Rajasthan state].

Domicile criteria

Admission to M.Pharm courses through RUHS M.Pharm Admissions 2025-26 is open to all residents of India.

Any change in fee structure by the State Level Fee Fixation Committee will be applicable to all the candidates. The candidates are required to pay the prescribed fee to the allotted institutions directly at the time of joining.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Before filling the **application form and choices**, read the information booklet etc. very carefully. Ensure the eligibility and other requirements for admission as given in this booklet.

You should be very careful in filling-up the online application form. Incomplete applications will not be entertained for allotment and applications with wrong information will lead to disqualifying the candidature at any time of the course of admission and education.

After completing the application form and filling the choices of college and specialization, prepare and keep two sets of application form along with photocopies of the following testimonials for submitting at the time of joining at the allotted college, along with the Original Certificates:

1. Date of Birth Certificate: 10th class mark sheet / certificate
2. Mark sheet of 10+2 (senior school certificate examination) or its equivalent
3. Copy of photo ID (Driving License / PAN card / Voter ID / Govt. or PSU card / School ID card / 12th class examination Admit Card / Aadhar Card)
4. Mark sheet of B.Pharm All Semesters/ years of examination
5. Migration Certificate (if passed B.Pharm from University other than RUHS)
6. Degree / Provisional certificate of B.Pharm
7. Domicile certificate of Rajasthan State, if applicable
8. Caste Certificate, if applicable
9. Valid GPAT score card, if applicable
10. Any other relevant certificate(s)

The RUHS / Admission Board reserves its right to alter and modify time and conditions laid down in the notification, information booklet for conducting the various stages up to the admission, duly intimating details thereof on the RUHS website, as warranted by any unforeseen circumstances arising during this process, or as deemed necessary by the RUHS / Admission Board at any stage.

ADMISISON PROCEDURE:

The admissions shall be made strictly in accordance with merit list prepared on the basis of percentage of marks in B.Pharm (aggregate of 4 years / 3 years in case for lateral entry admission to B.Pharm course) and the order of choices / options filled in by the candidates in the option form. While allotting a seat to a candidate, the relevant priority order (as mentioned under **Allotment of College and Course**) will be applicable. The candidates are advised to fill / exercise their choices/ options very carefully.

Important to note: If at any stage, it is found that a non-eligible candidate is admitted to a course, then the admission of such a candidate will be cancelled on such detection. A penal action may also be initiated against such candidate.

Allotment of College and Course:

The allotment process shall include the colleges approved by PCI, New Delhi (as per the list provided by RUHS, MMU).

The allotment of college and course shall be made in order of merit with the following allotment criteria / priority order:

Allotment criteria

Priority 1: Candidate who has obtained higher score in GPAT Examination 2025 and has passed B.Pharm course from a college / university of Rajasthan State.

Priority 2: Candidate who has obtained higher score in GPAT Examination 2025 and has passed B.Pharm course from a college / university of a State other than Rajasthan State.

Note: In Priority 1 and 2, candidates securing equal score in GPAT 2025 examination will be allotted a seat in the following order of preference:

1. One who has obtained higher percentage of marks in B.Pharm (aggregate of 4 years / 3 years in case for lateral entry admission to B.Pharm course)
2. One who has obtained higher aggregate percentage of in 10+2 examination
3. The candidate of higher age (older candidate)

Priority 3: Candidate who has obtained higher percentage of marks in B.Pharm (aggregate of 4 years/ 3 years in case for lateral entry admission to B.Pharm course) and has passed B.Pharm from a college/ university of Rajasthan State.

Priority 4: Candidate who has obtained higher percentage of marks in B.Pharm (aggregate of 4 years/ 3 years in case for lateral entry admission to B.Pharm course) and has passed B.Pharm from a college/ university of a State other than Rajasthan State.

Note: In Priority 3 and 4, candidates securing equal marks in B.Pharm course (aggregate of 4 years/ 3 years in case for lateral entry admission to B.Pharm course) will be allotted a seat in the following order of preference:

1. One who has obtained higher aggregate percentage in 10+2 examination
2. The candidate of higher age (older candidate)

After allotment of college, candidates will be informed about their allotment at RUHS website. Candidate is required to take a printout of the allotment letter and join at the allotted college along with requisite documents, in original, and prescribed fee, by the notified date.

The non-viewing of the RUHS website about allotment information by the candidate shall not be accepted as a ground for non-joining at the allotted college on the scheduled time and date. The candidate's allotment will stand automatically cancelled if he/ she does not report IN PERSON to the allotted college as per notified schedule.

No further allotments will be done by the Common Counseling Board 2025, after the scheduled FINAL round. The classes will be started as scheduled and further admissions will not be entertained by the RUHS M.Pharm Admissions 2025-26.

Joining at allotted college and depositing of fees & other documents:

At the time of joining at the allotted college, the candidate will have to carry printout of the allotment letter. The candidate is required to deposit prescribed fee along with original and one set of attested photocopies of requisite documents.

The allotment list shall be provided to the colleges. The colleges shall verify the credentials of reporting candidates as per this list and check the documents and other required certificates with originals.

Admissions on the vacant seats, drop-out seats

No admission shall be made after a date as notified by RUHS / Admission Board.

The decision of the RUHS / Admission Board shall be final and binding to all.

You should make sure of your eligibility etc. and that the declaration made by you in the format of application regarding your eligibility is correct in all respects. You will be liable to any legal action and / or punishment as may be deemed fit by RUHS M.Pharm Admissions 2025-26, in case it is found that you have furnished in-correct information or made false declaration regarding your eligibility at any stage or suppressed any information.

The admissions shall be treated as provisional subject to the final decision of any pending case(s) in any court of law, if applicable to these admissions. Further, the provisional status of admission shall stand cleared only after enrolment by the RUHS.

All the judgments relevant to these admissions, passed by any Hon'ble court of justice as well as rules existing at the time of making admissions will be applicable on these admissions and the candidates will have to abide compulsorily with such judgments, rules and the changes.

The jurisdiction for legal cases arising out of RUHS M.Pharm Admissions 2025-26 shall be limited to the High Court of Rajasthan, Jodhpur / Jaipur Bench.

The apex court drew guidelines for the management of all educational institutions to follow. Among them:

Educational institutions should take anti-ragging measures right from the time of advertisement for admissions. The prospectus, the form for admission and/or any other literature issued to aspirants for admission must clearly mention that ragging is banned in the institution and anyone indulging in it is likely to be punished appropriately which may include expulsion from the institution, suspension from the institution or classes for a limited period or fine with a public apology.

The punishment may also take the shape of: (i) withholding scholarships or other benefits (ii) debarring from representation in events (iii) withholding results (iv) suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess. If there be any legislation governing ragging or any provisions in statute/ordinance, it should be brought to the notice of the students/parents seeking admissions. A printed leaflet detailing when and to whom a victim may turn for information, help and guidance for various purposes, keeping in view the needs of new entrants, along with their addresses and telephone numbers should be given to fresher at the time of admissions so that they need not to look to seniors for help in such matters.
